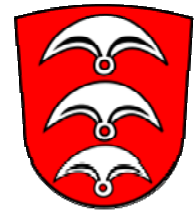

- Schwabenlandhalle as culture- and congress centre
regular theatre performances of touring ensembles take place there, too.
- the „Lutherkirche” (built from 1519 to 1524) is the most significant sight and a symbol of the city
- The „Alte Kelter” from 1906 (a hall for exhibitions and events), in its dimension and shape is a unique and impressive monument. As the greatest municipal “Kelterbau” of Baden-Wuerttemberg it is a connection between the traditional half-timbered architectural style and the imaginations of size of the buildings for industrial purpose.
- The town museum of Fellbach in a half-timbered house from 1680.
- The gallery of the city Fellbach is situated in the town hall – complex.
